OK Benefits - My Services integrates demographic, medical, and education information from OKDHS, Oklahoma Health Care Authority, and Oklahoma State Department of Education as a way to ensure children and providers have the most current medical and education information specific to each child in OKDHS or tribal custody.

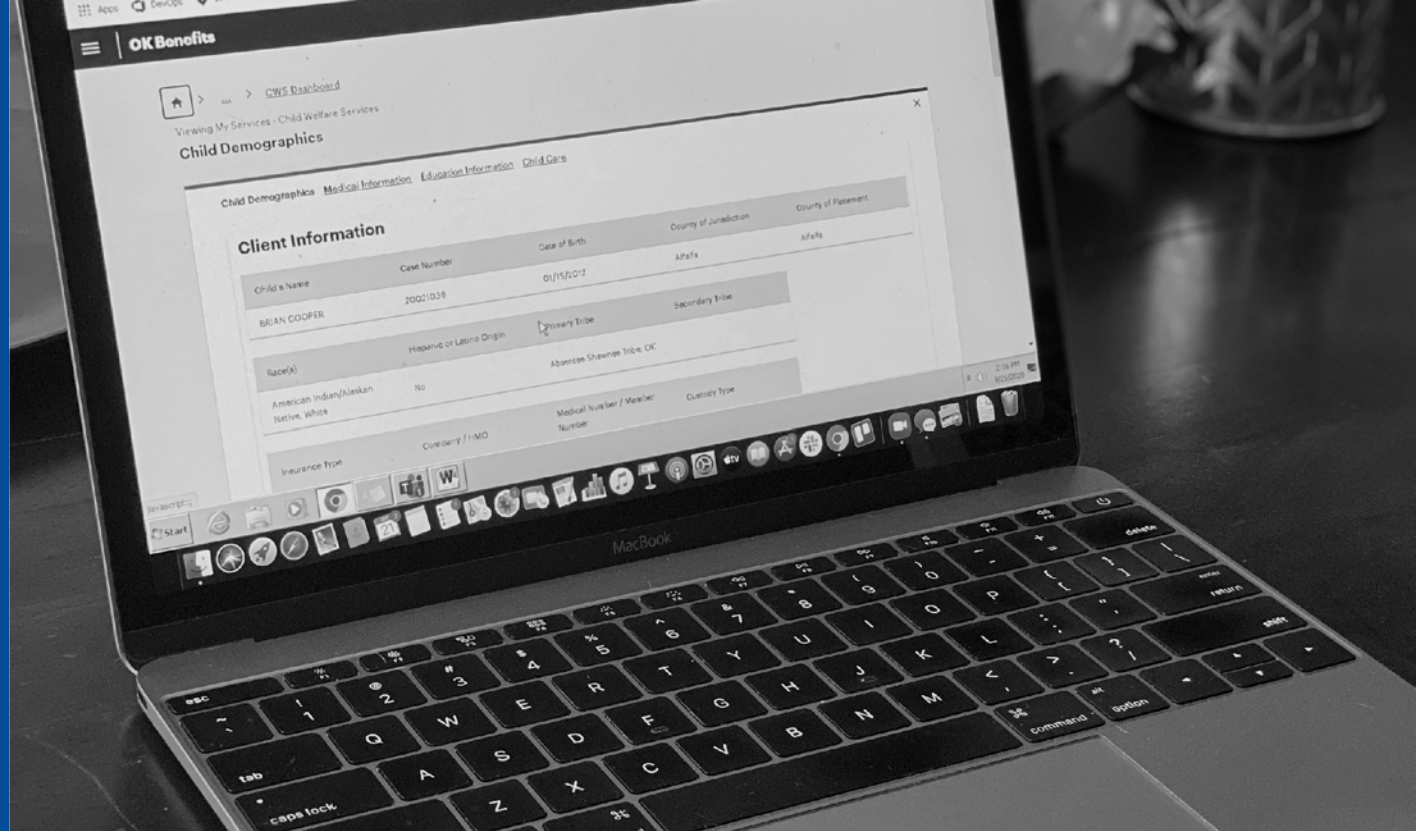


WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

Resource families now have the ability to access this information from our intuitive website and mobile-friendly format in the event that you need to enroll a child in school or fill out necessary paperwork at a doctor's office. It can even be used to provide service providers to meet the behavioral health needs of the child.

WHO HAS ACCESS?

Only you, the resource parent, has access to the Child's Passport. It is determined by account creation in the OK Benefits portal and the link with our child welfare reporting system.



WHAT INFO IS PROVIDED?

Current resource families will be able to access demographic, educational, medical, and childcare information in regard to the child placed in their home. Records include but are not limited to:

- Health Care Providers
- Early Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment Recommendations
- Immunizations
- Demographic Case Information
- Reasons the child came into care
- General behaviors of the child
- Previous and current prescription medications
- Disabilities
- Individualized Education Plan
