The Oklahoma Legislature is extending an invitation to 24 youth in Oklahoma Human Services (OKDHS) or Tribal custody to serve as pages for members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and Oklahoma Senate.

What is a Page?

- Serving as a Page is an excellent way to learn about and participate in the legislative process of our state.
- Pages serve as couriers, answer telephones, do research for members, and prepare the chamber floors for sessions, distributing legislation and papers. The duties rotate so pages have a chance to serve all functions.
- Foster youth in the 11th and 12th grade who are currently in DHS or Tribal custody and in out-of-home placement.
- OR who achieved permanency via guardianship or adoption after the age of 16.

Who can apply to be a Page?

Those accepted for this experience will:

- Receive a stipend to buy **new business clothes** for the event.
- Receive a food allowance for the week.
- Have an opportunity to spend time with a legislator from their area.
- Have **great experience** to put on a resume or scholarship application.
- Develop **permanent connections** with people at the Capitol.
